**PUBLIC HEARING(S)-LAND USE**

1. Conditional Use Petition No. 18-05; from Eric Glover; Petitioning to Amend Existing Conditional Use Permit to Allow Rental and Outdoor Storage of U-Haul Trucks and Trailers at 2830 Norwich Street and Provide Space for Washing Cars. (*J. Hunter*)

John Hunter, Planner/Historic Preservation Officer, Development and Codes, gave a presentation on the above-referenced petition; he stated applicant withdrew car wash activity from petition.

He reported that staff recommends granting the above-referenced petition.
