



SUBJECT:

COMMISSION ACTION REQUESTED ON: September 6, 2017

PURPOSE: To bring before the Commission the key facts and figures pertaining to securing software that will allow the City to bill and collect property taxes.

HISTORY: The RFP (#3-R) was posted on May 17, 2017, and the City received (4) four qualified bids prior to the June 1, 2017 deadline. The proposals were evaluated by a committee and the Commission narrowed the field down to two candidates for further review. Both vendors were allowed to provide demonstrations of their software to all interested parties that would be involved in making a decision as well as those persons that would potentially be using the software.

FACTS AND ISSUES: None to report

BUDGET INFORMATION: GovCollect - \$20,977 initial investment with \$3,147 in recurring annual fees. Tyler Technologies has an initial \$54,626 investment, with \$15,852 in recurring fees.


DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION ACTION: The Board of Commissioners will be given all of the information made available to the city and will make an informed decision based on that information.
