The City of Brunswick is currently seeking qualified **General Contractors and Sub-Contractors** for all housing rehabilitation trades to join our bidders list for the Community HOME Investment Program (CHIP). Through this program, the City will provide single-family housing rehabilitation to homeowners 62 years of age or older who reside within the property. The work to be performed will correct health and safety issues and serious deterioration such as a leaky roof, inadequate or no heat, deteriorated windows or doors, leaky pipes, and deteriorated exterior paint. **Non-essential items will not be a part of this program.**
