Bulk Waste: Collected once per month and must be scheduled by calling 912.267.3703.

Republic Services® will make available curbside collection of white goods, brown goods, and bulk waste on an as-scheduled basis from the requesting customer. Each customer shall be eligible to receive one bulk waste scheduled collection per month at no cost to the customer. If a customer requires additional pickups, Republic Services will assess separate charges/fees for the service directly from the customer.

General Specifications

Bulk Waste: Municipal solid waste composed of materials not easily containerized in a cart such as, but not limited to, appliances (with all CFC removed), furniture and other large items. Bulk waste does not include any form of matter or debris resulting from tree removal, land clearing or land development. Bulk waste shall exclude everything in the Excluded Waste list below. Bulk waste will not exceed 6 ft. x 6 ft. x 6 ft in size.

Commercial and Industrial Waste: All construction and demolition debris, garbage, rubbish and stable matter generated by a producer at a large commercial and industrial unit.

Excluded Waste: Excluded waste is all commercial and industrial waste, construction debris, carpet, large dead animals and institutional solid waste.
