Please describe the proposed work: Replace the headstone for Thomas Pitt Bunkley, Plot 97-B with a period duplicate headstone. The duplicate will be the same width and height, the thickness will increase to 3" to possibility to prevent future damage. The stone is currently Italian Marble which will be replaced with Georgia White Marble. Due to the availability of Italian Marble. The font will be matched a close as possible. The current stone had broken in half approx. 100yrs ago. With the bottom half let planted and the top-half replanted. During the 100+ years the top stone had begun "Sugaring" and deteriorating beyond repair.

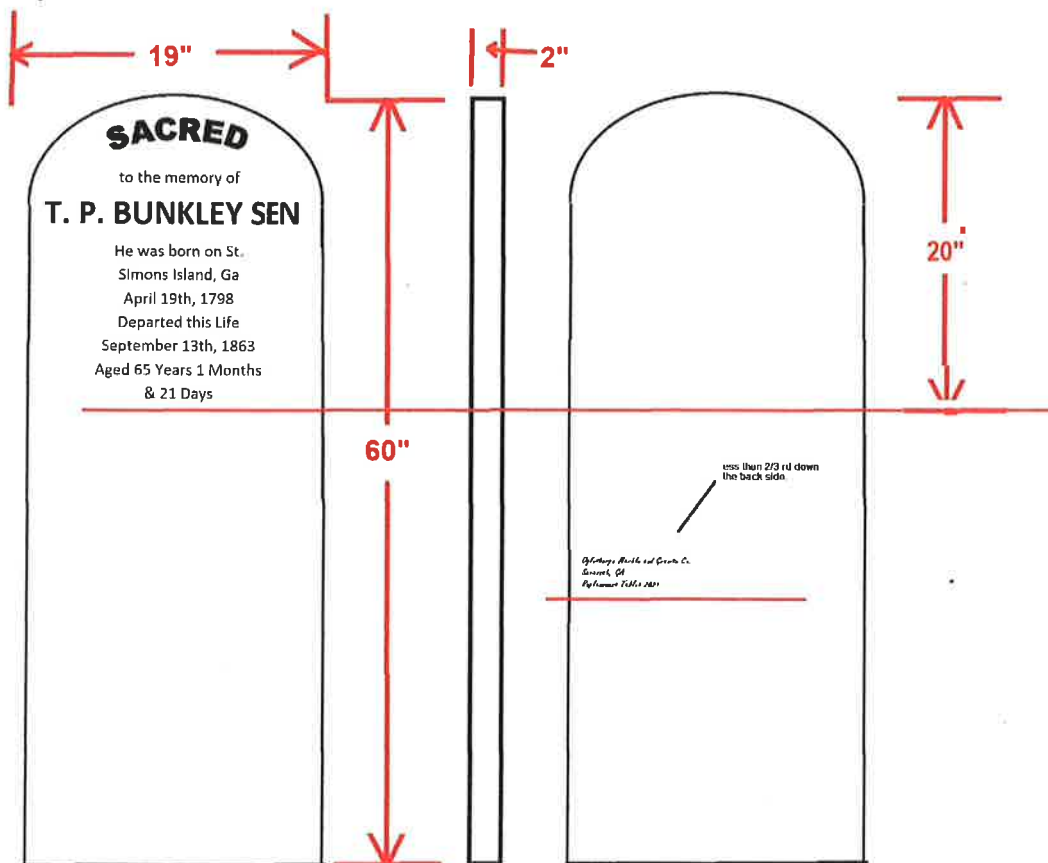
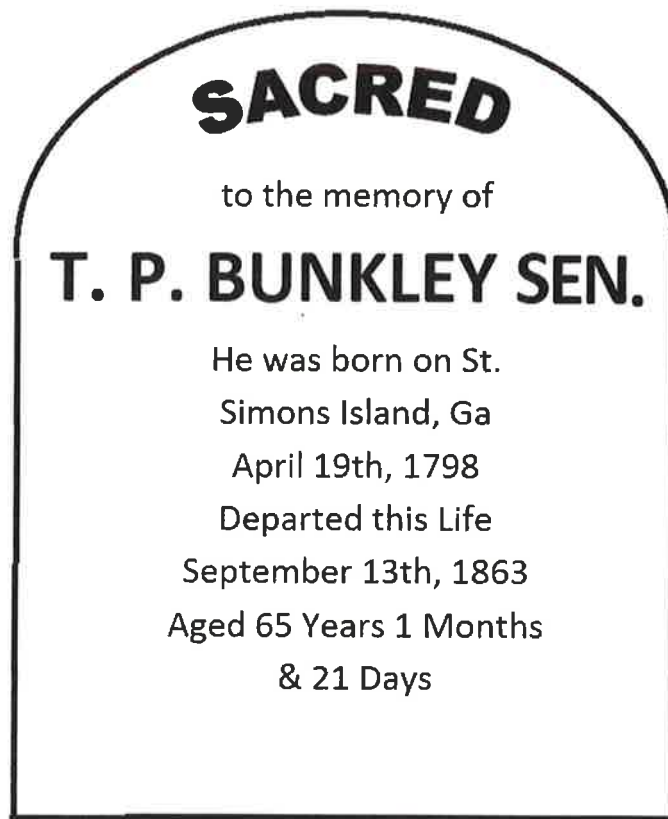
Before Repairing



After reinstallation of the stone, the back of the stone is slabbed with a piece of limestone in which the Head Stone has been epoxied to it. The bottom stone was cut off about 10" to get around the "Sugaring" and to put back together. The stone is VERY unstable.
