This home has been rented the last 10 plus years in the section 8 program. I am trying to bring the home up to standards with new windows and cosmetic upgrades that are in my budget. Half the windows were wood and half were metal frames and single pane (appears to be storm windows). The wood windows were repaired and patched the last 40 plus years. They appear to be the original windows. The windows and frames are rotten and just not repairable. I tried Bud Coffman to see if he can repair. I received quotes for windows about \$17k-\$23k and just not practical.

I bought windows from langs that will fit, the windows are wood inside.

All windows installed: using the existing opening -some of the framing is rotten so I had to replace, some windows are slightly smaller in width but the heights are basically right on.

The house is stucco and will add Stucco for any gaps and all windows will be wrapped with a thick 1x8. The body of the house will be painted to match the neighborhood and a new metal roof over the front porch.



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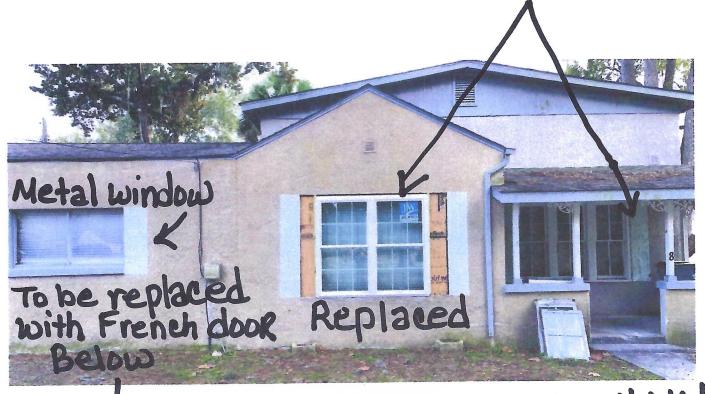
