**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Mayor Pro Tem Martin made a motion to hold an executive session to discuss litigation; seconded by Commissioner Harris. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

**RECONVENE FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION** – *(7:02 p.m.)*

Following executive session Mayor Harvey announced no action was taken.

**DISCUSSION(S)**

1. Revision to Stormwater Management Ordinance. *(G. Alberson)*

Commissioner Cason made a motion to defer the above-referenced item until the November 18, 2020 commission meeting; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Martin. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

2. Consider Approval of October 21, 2020 Regular Scheduled Meeting Minutes. *(subject to any necessary changes.) (N. Atkinson)*

Mayor Pro Tem Martin made a motion to approve the above-referenced minutes; seconded by Commissioner Cason. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

3. Decision Regarding Confederate Monument Located in Hanover Square.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to defer the above-referenced item until the November 18, 2020 commission meeting; seconded by Commissioner Cason. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

4. Consider Approval of Financial Reports as of September 30, 2020. *(K. Mills)*

Mayor Pro Tem made a motion to approve the above-referenced reports as submitted; seconded by Commissioner Williams. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

5. Consider Approval of Budget Adjustment – Adding of Stormwater Utility Crew. *(G. Alberson)*

Mayor Pro Tem Martin made a motion to approve the above-referenced budget adjustment; with the caveat to review any need for trucks or equipment and be judicious regarding spending for same; seconded by Commissioner Williams. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

6. Consider Approval of Seventeen (17) Alcohol Beverage License Renewals. *(R. Monday) (see attachment)*

Commissioner Cason made a motion to approve the above-referenced alcohol beverage license renewals; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Martin. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.

7. Discussion of Mellon Foundation Grant.

City Manager McDuffie gave an overview of the above-referenced grant; stating no further action was warranted until a decision was made on how the monument would be handled.

Commissioner Cason made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Martin. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.
