**ITEM(S) TO CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL**

1. Consider Approval of June 6, 2018 Work Session and Regular Scheduled Meeting Minutes, June 11, 2018 Work Session Minutes and June 13, 2018 Work Session Minutes. (*subject to any necessary changes.*) (*N. Atkinson*)  
Commissioner Cason made a motion to approve the above-referenced minutes; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Harris. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 5 to 0.
