Sealed bid proposals for the **LANIER BOULEVARD RESURFACING & GLOUCESTER RRFB CROSSING PROJECT** within the City of Brunswick will be received at the City of Brunswick Office of Public Works, 525 Lakewood Avenue, Brunswick, Georgia, Attention City Engineer, until 10:00 A.M., legal prevailing time on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, at that time to be publicly opened and read aloud. No Bid may be withdrawn after closing for a period of 30 calendar days.

A pre-bid meeting will be held in the conference room at City of Brunswick Public Works, 525 Lakewood Ave, Brunswick, Georgia, on Wednesday, May 8, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. All potential bidders are encouraged to attend this meeting.

This project consists of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary for **Lanier Boulevard resurfacing and shoulder widening & Gloucester Street RRFB crossing, plus milling and resurfacing of various streets** including cleanup and any incidental work thereto to complete the project. All work is to meet specifications and/or standards of the City of Brunswick and to include any addendums thereof.

Project will include:

- Milling existing asphalt pavement;
- Widening paved roadway shoulder;
- Placement of asphalt concrete pavement;
- Installation of Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacon pedestrian crossing;
- Thermoplastic pavement marking

All bidders must be licensed to conduct business of this nature in the State of Georgia. Bidders must be fully insured so as to save the City of Brunswick harmless as a result of any action or accident related to this project. A Bid Bond of 10% of the amount of the bid must accompany the bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the total Contract amount.

During the course of construction, the contractor shall have a superintendent on the site at all times during performance of the work. Monthly progress pay requests may be submitted to the City Engineer for payment. The City will honor same within 30 days after receipt.

The City of Brunswick, owner, reserves the right to reject any and all bids, negotiate, waive informalities and/or make the award in the best interest of the City of Brunswick.
