

ORDINANCE NO. 1070

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK TO AMEND CHAPTER 25, CLEAN COMMUNITY ORDINANCE; TO PROVIDE FOR LITTER CONTROL AT CONSTRUCTION SITES; TO PROVIDE CODIFICATION; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The commission of the City of Brunswick hereby ordains that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Brunswick be amended as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Sec. 25-13 Litter on occupied private property.

No person shall throw or deposit litter on any occupied property within the City, whether owned by such person or not, except that the owner or person in control of private property may maintain Authorized Receptacles for collection in such a manner that litter will be prevented from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any street, sidewalk or other public place or upon any private property.

Sec. 25-13.1 Dropping litter from watercraft, aircraft.

No person in an watercraft or aircraft shall throw out, drop or deposit any litter within the City.

Sec. 25-13.2 Private property to be maintained free of litter.

The owner, occupant, or person in control of any private property shall at all times maintain the premises free of litter; provided, however, this section shall not prohibit the storage of litter in authorized receptacles for collection.

Sec. 25-13.3 Litter on vacant lots.

No person shall throw or deposit litter on any open or vacant private property within the City, whether owned by such person or not.

Sec. 25-13.4 Control of Litter and Debris on Construction Sites

Construction site operators, whether the site be residential, commercial or otherwise, must control waste such as discarded building materials, concrete truck washout, chemicals, litter, and sanitary waste at the construction site that may cause adverse impacts to water quality.

SECTION TWO

All City of Brunswick code sections, ordinances, and parts of codes sections and ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby waived for the sole purpose of this ordinance only and shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE

If any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR:

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
